	<p>Cloud-Based Door Entry</p>	<p>Cloud-based door entry intercom systems make everyday life easier for residents and simplify management for property managers. With a cloud-based solution, a visitor can press the call button on the door station to call a tenant from the building entrance. The tenant can communicate and open the door for the visitor from their mobile device.</p> <p>A cloud-based intercom solution using mobile devices eliminates both cabling to and intercom stations in every apartment unit. For those without a mobile device, the system allows a traditional phone number to be called, so tenants can communicate and unlock the door. Since no physical equipment is required onsite, cloud solutions also maximize the ROI on your building footprint, and they minimize staff costs, because no IT support is needed.</p>
	<p>Single Credentials</p>	<p>Today's modern access control systems can use a single mobile credential, keyfob, or card, to open all appropriate doors and access secure spaces. For residents, this means keeping track of a single credential rather than multiple credentials or keys.</p> <p>For property managers, it simplifies operations and management through a single system and user interface that controls all doors that are part of the access control system, whether they are common entry doors or individual apartment unit doors. Electronic locks, readers and credentials also provide enhanced security levels, because property managers can set unique levels of access rights by person, by time of day, and by door.</p>
	<p>Wireless Locksets</p>	<p>Wireless lock solutions deliver significant benefits over traditional mechanical locks and key systems. Wireless lock systems minimize site visits and reduce installation and operational costs. Using wireless locks on apartment entries provides convenience and extends access control from building entry to apartment entry.</p> <p>They also simplify apartment turnover and eliminate the need to change or rekey locks. Security is increased since there are no keys to be lost, copied, or shared with unauthorized users. Additional benefits include providing audit trail reports by opening and by user, ability to limit accessibility as needed, and ability to cost effectively integrate with other systems.</p>
	<p>Mobile Credentials</p>	<p>Mobile credentials establishes a new experience for residents. Not only is it more convenient, deploying mobile credentials makes new services more attainable, such as dog walking, housecleaning, in-unit deliveries, and more.</p>

This provides flexibility and a simple way to provide temporary or scheduled access for friends, family, babysitters, and trusted service providers while providing an audit trail and a record of every visitor.

Restricted Community Access and Parking

Secure Package Rooms

Openpath's Video Intercom Reader Pro can be installed on the building entry door to allow couriers to call the property management office or use an access control credential to gain access to the building. Installing a Video Pro Reader on the package room door provides both access control and video surveillance of whomever enters the package room. Increased surveillance can be achieved by using Ava video surveillance cameras integrated with the Openpath access control system.

Elevator Access Control

Adding access control to elevators enables property managers and tenants alike to secure and control access to specific floors based on the permissions assigned to them. Visitors can be assigned temporary access to selected floors for a defined period of time. This allows the visitor to walk through the building lobby, enter the elevator, select the correct floor, and travel to the desired apartment, without providing unrestricted access to other floors in the building.
